What is AMP?

- The ECSE School's **Accelerated Master's Program (AMP)** let's qualified students earn both their **CSE, ECE** or **SFWE** bachelor's and master's degrees in as little as **five years (4+1)**.
- As an AMP student, you can take up to **12 units of 500-level courses** during your undergraduate studies. These courses count toward **both your BS and MS degrees**, helping you save time and tuition while fast-tracking your graduate education.

Why consider AMP?

- According to the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), individuals with a master's degree earn, on average, 10% to 20% more than those with a bachelor's degree.
- Quicker advancement. More interesting day-to-day activities.
- Competitive advantage.

Eligibility:

- An ECSE School application code is required
- A minimum GPA of 3.30
- 90 earned Undergraduate units

Application Information:

- Application fee, required by the University of Arizona Graduate College
- U of A academic transcripts. Download unofficial transcripts from UAccess and upload to the application.
- Current résumé
- Personal statement of interest

Requirement:

- Students must maintain a **3.30 GPA** throughout the program.
